About the Albert J. Solnit Children's Center

As a facility of the Connecticut Department of Youth and Families, the Albert J. Solnit Children's Center provides brief treatment, residential care, and educational instruction for abused and neglected youth between the ages of 13 and 17. Youth come to the facility from all over the state.

About the Youth

- Approximately 50 youth; boys and girls
- Most are 13 to 17 years old; average age is 16.
- Many wear large clothes: Adult sizes M, L, XL or XXL
- Most youth stay with us from three –six months.
- About 150 youth stay at the facility each year.
